



House of Kids Infant Policy

1. The infant room is for infants only; no other children will be allowed in the room.
2. Each infant will be assigned a bed in which they will sleep. All infants will be diapered on the changing table, the area will be covered with wax paper during diapering, and then disposed of, and the area bleached.
3. The State Board of Health requires that only ready-to-feed formula in unopened cans be used. Diapers must be furnished in an unopened package, and baby food in unopened jars. We cannot take children in cloth diapers.
4. All infants must have at least one change of clothes in a shoebox in their cubbies. The Board of Health does not allow diaper bags.
5. All infants must be at least six weeks old.
6. In order to keep all of the babies healthy; we cannot watch sick children. We will contact the parent, if the child runs a fever, has diarrhea or vomits, and other arrangements must be made.
7. We will chart when the baby eats, sleeps, is changed, and their behavior. These charts will be available for the parents.
8. If the baby takes a pacifier, please bring the one they like, and mark it, so we can identify the owner.
9. The Feeding Plan needs to be signed by a doctor for the child's first day.
10. We will need the following items: formula, baby food, disposable diapers, change of clothes, Feeding Chart, Intake Agreement, Health Form, prescription for any medicine, and any medicines.
